**Shedding Light on Hunger Program
Whitewater Valley REMC Employees Donate Funds to Local Nonprofit**

Liberty, Ind. – Friday, May 1, 2020 – The Whitewater Valley REMC Shedding Light on Hunger program supports one of the cooperative principles – Concern for Community. To support nonprofits who are working to help our communities during this time and in need of funding, the employees are giving the Union County Foundation \$2,500. The funds are earmarked for a \$1,000 donation to the Liberty Food Bank; \$1,000 to the College Corner Food Bank; and \$500 to Community Cares. Other local organizations receiving funds from the cooperative include Communities in Schools - \$1,500; Crosspointe Biker Church - \$1,500; and the Feeding Western Wayne Organization - \$500.

100% of funding for the Shedding Light on Hunger program comes from employees of the cooperative, donations from the cooperative's partners and money raised from the annual charity golf tournament.
