Local Schools Receive Funds from Whitewater Valley REMC

Donations part of the co-op's 25 Acts of Kindness program.

Liberty, Ind. – April 17, 2019 – The Whitewater Valley REMC has awarded eight local schools funds in the amount of \$2,081.00. These funds will be used to assist in paying past due lunch fees for seniors currently enrolled in the schools.

“The funds provided by the WWVREMC will pay-off a majority of all outstanding senior lunch fees.” WWVREMC Director of Member Services and Corporate Relations, Sandy Cason said. WWVREMC will use money from their Shedding Light on Hunger fund for the project. Employees and directors also made personal donations to the project.

The project is part of the cooperative’s 25 Acts of Kindness program and part of a year-long celebration for the cooperative’s 25th anniversary. WWVREMC plans to perform 25 Acts of Kindness throughout its service territory. The cooperative has already helped several local organizations including Head Start

In the last six years, WWVREMC’s Shedding Light on Hunger program has helped to distribute almost 8,000 pounds of food to local food banks, providing over 1,000 meals to local families in need.
